## Driving Directions to 139 Charles Street...

*Google is next to useless for our location! Google will say that Arlington street is closed, which is not true.*

*Arlington is a designated "Slow Street" in San Francisco. That means that it is open to local traffic only, so that it can be used for walkers, cyclists, etc. But we are "local", as are our friends and guests, such as yourself!*

### From the South Bay:

Easiest route....

- Take 280 north into San Francisco, following signs to San Francisco/Bay Bridge
- Take exit 52 (2 right Lanes) to San Jose Avenue.
  - Follow San Jose Avenue to the 1st stop light, at Randall Street.
- Turn RIGHT onto Randall Street, and immediately, turn RIGHT onto Mission Street.
- At the 2nd stoplight on Mission Street, turn RIGHT onto Highland Avenue, and cross the bridge.
- At the stop sign, turn RIGHT onto Arlington, being mindful of possible walkers, skateboarders, etc. In a very short distance, turn LEFT onto Charles St., which is a narrow, one-way street.

### From the East Bay:

From the Bay Bridge... is the least-annoying route from there!

- Take 80 and 101 into San Francisco.
- Take exit 431 to merge onto 280 South.
- Take exit 52 for Monterey Blvd.
  - At the end of the long ramp, take the very sharp RIGHT onto Monterey Blvd.
- About a block later at the stop light, turn LEFT onto Diamond Street., stay in the right lane to continue on Diamond street...1 stoplight, then 1 stop sign, at Chenery Street.
- Turn RIGHT onto Chenery Street, continue about 3/4 mile, to Miguel Street.
- Turn RIGHT onto Miguel, go one block.
- At the stop sign, turn LEFT onto Arlington, being mindful of possible walkers, skateboarders, etc. After the next stop sign, go a bit further, then turn LEFT onto Charles St., which is a narrow, one-way street. Start looking for parking on Arlington.

We are at 139 Charles, with a gingko tree (bare right now) in front. Grey stucco house front, wooden porch.

There is often parking on our short street, and there is usually easy parking on Arlington, as well.
